


#### 17 GUIs

#### 17.1 View Site - Internal User

When an internal user clicks on 'View Site', the Site Locale page is displayed.

If no site is selected, only the search widget is visible and the user will have to do a search. The search results are then displayed at the bottom of the page.

If a site is selected, the search widge is visible and the site and its locale(s) are displayed at the bottom of the page. The Internal User will still be able to do a search on **all** sites.



#### Page Notes: Search results

This area is displayed:

(a) after user does a search

(b) if a site is already selected, the user clicks on View Site' in left nav and the selected site has multiple locales

#### 17.2 View Site - External User (site is selected)

The Site Locale page is presented to the external user if a site is selected in the left nav and the selected site has more than one locale. Otherwise, if the selected site has only one locale, when the user clicks on View Site the site is displayed in a new window and this page is not displayed.

NOTE: search widget is not available to external user



#### 17.3 View Site - External User (no site is selected)

If the user's company has multiple sites and no site is selected in the left nav, when the user clicks on View Site the Site Locale page is displayed with a list of the selected company's sites and locales.

NOTE: search widget is not available to external user
